Winter golf has returned to Redmond Ridge! We hope our players notice that the course is a little less soggy than in past years. It's been a fun season so far dealing with the extreme cold, snowfall, and winds that took quite a bit of effort to recover from. Last year we continued with punching the fairways to help with the thatch accumulation and it looks to be paying off. The turf team has spent a lot of time locating drains and ensuring they are functioning, trimming up trees, and cleaning up the landscaping around the course. Clearing of unwanted vegetation will continue throughout the next several months and we hope to have a much tidier presentation for the 2023 season. We have been keeping up with our winter fertility program on the greens, ensuring they are getting adequate amounts of nutrients, specifically potassium since that is an essential nutrient for winter stress and disease prevention. Overall we are excited about what the growing season will look like and we hope to see a marked improvement of the course.

Our goal for 2023 is to promote the restaurant more and get some more outside events scheduled that the community and our members can come and enjoy. Currently we have Pasta Night on Wednesdays, Prime Rib Night on Fridays, and Chef's Specials on Saturday.
