

# Weekly 'Game Day' Events for the 2025 season begins on May 6, 2025.

Entry fees for Game Day are included in the Tuesday Ladies' Club green fees. OKI members must pay a separate \$5.00 fee on Game Days as the entry fee is not included with the OKI membership fee.

The number of flights and winners varies weekly based on the number of participants. Winners will receive retail credit to use in the Redmond Ridge Pro Shop.

#### **Golf Genius App**

The Ladies' Club uses Golf Genius to record our scores on Game Days. Please download the app to your phone using one of these links:

### **Weekly Game Days and Putting Contest:**

Each week will feature a different game format with winners receiving retail credit for the Pro Shop. The name and description of the game is available when you sign into the Golf Genius app on Game Day and will be sent out in email the day prior to the Game Day. Each week there is also a putting contest. Players with the lowest putts within each flight win Pro Shop retail credit. The number of flights and winners varies weekly based on the number of participants.

### Keeping Score

Assign one master scorekeeper for your group who will enter hole-by-hole scores for each player into the Golf Genius app\*. Assign a secondary scorekeeper to track the hole-by-hole scores **and putts**\*\* for each player on a physical card.

After leaving each green, each player's score and putts should be agreed upon and recorded in Golf Genius and

# Eligibility for Game Day and Contests

To be eligible to participate in the Game Day, Tournament Days, Putting Contests, Birdie and ECCY, a member must be in good standing with dues paid for the current year.

The player must maintain a GHIN handicap; On Game Days, Golf Genius will automatically post your score in GHIN. On non-Game Days' the player is responsible for posting all eligible rounds into GHIN (the app or online website).

Players must play to a maximum 40 handicap in all tournament events (such as Member/Guest and Member/Member).

The Tournament Chairs determine and post the rules for each tournament. Any member in good standing may enter tournaments, but must play to a handicap no higher than 40. If you have no established GHIN handicap, you must play to a zero handicap.

Players must play to course handicap in Weekly Game and Tournament Days.

the physical master scorecard before starting the next hole. If there is a disagreement, address it with the Rules Chair or Pro Shop after the round. Do <u>not</u> submit the final scoring into the Golf Genius app until agreement is made on the hole score.

At the end of the round, each player will confirm their holeby-hole scores with the master scorekeeper. Once agreed upon, the master scorekeeper submits the final scores in the Golf Genius app.

The secondary scorekeeper will confirm the hole-by-hole scores and **the putts** at the same time. The master physical scorecard must be dropped in the scorecard box in the Pro Shop directly following the round in order to qualify for the day's putting contest.

\*On Game Days, Golf Genius will automatically update your score into GHIN. All other times when you complete a round, it is the player's responsibility to enter their scores into GHIN to keep your handicap current.

\*\*Count the number of putts once you are on the "green".

Once the final scores are submitted, the winners will be calculated. The number of flights and winners varies weekly based on the number of participants. Winners will be notified in a weekly communication that includes winner's name, flight, and Pro Shop retail credits earned.

### **Ineligibility Situations**

- If a final scorecard is submitted in Golf Genius with missing or incorrect information for a player, the player will be disqualified from the Game Day event and/or putting contest (there is no refund for Game Day fee).
- If you pick up your ball and input an X on a hole you are disqualified from the Game Day event and/or Putting contest. You are still eligible for Birdie and Eccy for the day (see descriptions for these below).

#### **Retail Credits**

Winners will receive "Retail Credits" that are deposited weekly in their individual accounts at the Pro Shop. Retail credits may be used to purchase retail product in the Pro Shop. They <u>cannot</u> be used for gift cards, paying for green fees or at the Crooked Spoon. These "retail credits" accrue throughout the year and expire on December 31, 2025.

# Playing on Game Days/Putting Contests/Birdie and ECCY

For the putting contests, putts must be holed out. This is true on temporary greens as well. No automatic two putts or "gimmies" are allowed.

Count all strokes, including whiffs and penalties.

You must count and record all strokes for Game Day. Do not enter an adjusted score into Golf Genius.

Example: You have 10 strokes on a hole, you post the 10 score.

Birdie Contest	Eccy Contest

Birdie Contest for the 2025 season begins on May 6, 2025 and ends the week before the Last Hurrah.

All Ladies' Club members may participate (entry fee covered by RR Ladies' Club). You must be a Ladies' Club member to qualify. Once you join the club and pay your dues, you are eligible. All birdies before joining do not qualify for the birdie contest.

Qualifying Birdie's (or lower) are <u>only</u> on RR Ladies' Club Game Days and Tournament Days that are <u>not</u> shotguns. Birdies are automatically tracked and recorded in Golf Genius on Game and Tournament Days.

Scorecards in Golf Genius with incomplete information will be disqualified.

Winners will be determined based on the total number of natural birdies made during league play on Game and Tournament Days. Number of winners will be determined at the end of the season based on the budget.

There is a 'Birdie Tree' in the Crooked Spoon Restaurant where we post the members who make Birdie's (and the hole number) during league play on Game or Tournament Days. Eccy Contest for the 2025 season begins on May 6, 2025 and ends the week before the Last Hurrah.

All Ladies' Club members may participate (entry fee covered by RR Ladies' Club). You must be a Ladies' Club member to qualify. Once you join the club and pay your dues, you are eligible.

How Eccy is calculated: Payout is based on NET score (Best score minus course handicap). Your best score on each hole throughout the season on Game Days only is totaled and the course handicap is subtracted. Number of winners will be determined at the end of the season based on the budget

You must play a minimum of 6 rounds of golf (18 or 9) to qualify.

You must have a handicap by the end of the season.

Scorecards in Golf Genius with incomplete information will be disqualified.
